# NEW PASSWORDS! **JANUARY 1, 2023**

In order to maintain privacy and security for members in an ever-evolving electronic age, the P.E.O. International member website password will be updated on January 1, 2023.

All passwords will have the current year added to the end. For example, the new password for members will be formatted like this. with

the original password filling in the blanks: \_\_\_\_\_2023. Nebraska's website password will also change on January 1 to coincide with the International update.

# PHISHING:

**NHAT HAPPENED?** 

WE WERE RECENTLY INFORMED THAT EMAILS PRETENDING TO BE ON BEHALF OF STATE. PROVINCIAL AND DISTRICT CHAPTER PRESIDENTS WERE SENT TO LOCAL CHAPTER PRESIDENTS ASKING FOR A FAVOR TO PURCHASE GIFTS CARDS.

THIS IS A COMMON FORM OF FRAUD CALLED PHISHING. PHISHERS SEND EMAILS PRETENDING TO BE SOMEONE ELSE SO THEY CAN CONVINCE YOU TO PROVIDE FINANCIAL SUPPORT. THE EMAIL MAY EVEN BE SPOOFED. WHICH MEANS IT DISPLAYS THE NAME OR EMAIL ADDRESS OF THE SENDER THE SCAMMER CLAIMS TO REPRESENT. ALL OF THE EMAILS THAT WE HAVE SEEN COME FROM A GMAIL ACCOUNT.

PLEASE KNOW P.E.O. HAS NOT AND WILL NOT ASK YOU TO PURCHASE GIFT CARDS OR SOLICIT DONATIONS TO OTHER CHARITIES. BECAUSE YOU ARE A P.E.O. MEMBER, WE ARE NOTIFYING YOU OF THIS FRAUDULENT EFFORT TO SOLI<mark>CIT</mark> FUNDS FROM OUR MEMBERS.

- ALWAYS CALL TO VERIFY SOMETHING BEFORE YOU RESPOND WHEN IT CONCERNS MONEY, NAMES AND LOOK CAREFULLY AT SPELLING IN EMAIL
  - ADDRESSES AND REQUEST.

THE ONLY INFORMATION THAT THE FRAUDSTER APPEARS TO WHAT INFORMATION WAS INVOLVED? HAVE IS PUBLICLY-AVAILABLE INFORMATION SUCH AS NAMES, ADDRESSES, PHONE NUMBERS AND EMAILS. IT IS IMPORTANT TO REALIZE THAT P.E.O. DOES NOT COLLECT OR RETAIN MEMBER BIRTH DATES, SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS (FOR U.S. MEMBERS) BANKING INFORMATION OR CREDIT CARDS. INTERNATIONAL'S IT DEPARTMENT CONTINUES TO MONITOR

What You Can Do? If you receive a suspicious email: 1. Delete the email immediately. 2 Do not click on any links. 3. please do not reply to these spoofed 4. Do not send funds or gift cards. 5. Generally speaking, if it seems either "too good" or "too bad" to be true, it likely is.
