EDUCATIONAL LOAN FUND

February greetings, Sisters! Did you know that the humble and hardworking P.E.O. Educational Loan Fund was the first loan fund in the world established just for women? Besides sharing this historical nugget, I wanted to address a commonly asked question and pass along a helpful tip. First, the question:

Why do we need to have two cosigners for each loan applicant, regardless of credit score? Because real life can happen to ELF loan recipients, creating situations in which they are unable to make good on their loans. ELF loans are unsecured loans, meaning we require no collateral from the applicants, so we need a method in place that will help to ensure repayment in case an ELF applicant does have to default on her loan. Sometimes only one of the two cosigners can honor their obligation to back up the loan, due to their own circumstances or even death. Asking that the note is guaranteed by two signatures allows P.E.O. to continue to offer unsecured loans, which are far more accessible and cost effective (they're lower in operational and administrative fees than secured loans). This dual signature method ensures we can continue offering low interest loans to women whose education may depend on them.

Next, the tip: when assisting your candidates with the application process, please encourage them to double check tuition due dates and allow for payment processing time. We want to avoid any angst and allow for a seamless transfer of funds from the ELF office to the school finance office in time for the new semester/quarter.

As always, I'm happy to address any questions. Thank you for sharing your chapters' and recipients' celebrations and concerns with me; it's the very best part of this role!

1. All you need to do is send a check, along with a note, detailing who your resident is and what service you are requesting along with your chapter information.

2. Staff at the Home will create and print a "Gift Certificate" for your resident from your chapter and see that she gets it.

3. IF you have a special card to accompany the certificate, be sure to include that "unsealed" card and the certificate will be placed in it for you and then delivered to the resident.
