

INTERESTING FACTS ABOUT ELF



March greetings, Sisters!

I've been getting a few questions lately about the Educational Loan Fund interest rate, so I thought I'd address your query while sharing a bit of ELF interest history.

The interest charged on an ELF loan currently remains at 2%. Available funds and loan demand play a major role in determining the rate in this privately funded educational loan. So, much like the maximum loan amount, the interest rates have been adjusted over the years to better serve women students while keeping the fund in balance. Let's look at some pivotal years:

- 1909 The P.E.O. Educational Loan Fund is established, and the interest rate is set at 4%.
- 1935 As program participation wanes during the Great Depression, the interest rate is lowered to 3% in an effort to stimulate loan activity.
- 1952 ELF is on a sold roll, granting its 10,000th loan.
- 1963 More young women than ever are attending college, and ELF proves to be a great financial tool for meeting educational needs. Interest is returned to the original 4% rate.
- 1982 Loan demand is quite high, making fewer dollars available. As a result, the interest rate is raised to 6%.
- 1987 A growing Educational Loan Fund balance makes it possible to lower the interest rate once again to 4%.
- 2004 As chapter donations and successful loan activity continue, the ELF interest rate reaches an exciting alltime low of 2%!
- 2023 Due to the generous contributions of chapters and a well-managed fund by the board of trustees, ELF interest rate currently remains at 2%.

Fun ELF factoid: 1941 applicants were reminded that loans must be paid in full prior to marriage. Haven't we come a long way, baby?

As always, I enjoy chatting with you and am happy to address any questions. As convention time draws near, I would love to hear of your chapter's success and your exemplary recipients – it's the stuff project displays are made of!
