Changes to the Website!

We have all experienced the undesired side of technology-our email address being stolen, our Facebook account being hacked or other online accounts being compromised. Unfortunately, International Chapter has not been immune to such struggles, as we all recall when last year the International website was down for an extended period of time due to such an assault.

Because of this, in order to prevent this from happening again, a big change is in the works for all who use the P.E.O. websites, including our very own Nebraska state website! Rather than all of us using the same username and password to access all P.E.O. websites, we will all use our very own! If you do any type of online banking, purchasing, etc., you should already know what this is about. We will use the acronym "SSO" for this new authentication method-Single Sign On. We hope this new process of using unique credentials will help alleviate any further issues of account hacking and subsequent shutdowns of the websites.

In preparation of this upcoming change, ALL members need to do TWO things!

- Make sure you know your Member ID number.
- Make sure your email address has been submitted on the International website.

Both items will be necessary in order for you to use SSO to access the Nebraska website. At this point, this is for the Nebraska website only! Instructions for the International website will be forthcoming in the near future.

So that you know that you are set to go:

- Find your Member ID on the label of your P.E.O. Record. The second line of the label has your (chapter letters)||NE followed by your Member ID number **OR**
- To find your ID number and check on your email address:
 - Go to the Quick Links at the bottom of the home page on the International website and click on "<u>Member Update</u>."
 - Select "Look up ID", fill out the short form and submit to retrieve your ID number.
 - Then "Use this ID" and "Continue" to take you to the Member Update page. There you will be able to verify your email address or submit it, if need be!
- If you know your Member ID, follow the instructions above by going to the Member Update page and submitting your number to verify or submit your email address.

Please take the time to check on these two items right away so that when the update is upon us, you will be set to go! We want this change to be as seamless as possible. We need all Nebraska P.E.O. members to join in this effort to achieve this goal!

Become a PCE Brighter Tomorrow Chapter!

*A chapter that makes a lump sum contribution of \$500 or more will be designated a PCE Brighter Tomorrow Chapter.

* To receive recognition, the CHAPTER contribution must be received by the state paid assistant by January 31. Make the check payable to Nebraska State Chapter P.E.O.

* Individual contributions of \$500 or more also allow a local chapter to receive recognition as a PCE Brighter Tomorrow Chapter, provided the donor specifies the chapter to be credited on the Individual Donation Form. To be considered a charitable donation, this contribution must be made payable to Program for Continuing Education and be sent to the Executive Office. The deadline for these designated gifts is January 31.


Chapter Recognition:

P.E.O. EDUCATIONAL LOAN FUND (ELF)



As school is getting back in session for most, there are women out there looking for assistance in funding their education as they pursue their degree or professional training. And the good news is that the P.E.O. Educational Loan Fund (ELF) Board of Trustees has made getting a low interest loan one step easier for these women.

DID YOU HEAR? Effective July 1, 2023, ELF applicants will only need to identify ONE qualified cosigner for their loan! The change from two cosigners to a single cosigner will make it easier for eligible women to apply for and secure this 2% interest loan.

With this new eligibility change our qualifications for an interested woman to apply for and be

considered are as follows:

- Recommendation by a local chapter of the P.E.O. Sisterhood with a favorable vote on the amount of the loan
 - Loans Amounts:
 - \$12,000 for Associates, Bachelors, Technical or Professional Training Programs and Post
 - Graduate Certifications
 - \$15,000 for Master's Degrees
 - \$20,000 for Doctoral Degree Programs
- A citizen or legal permanent resident of the U.S. or Canada, resides in the U.S. or Canada
- Submits the application within 6–24 months prior to stated graduation or course completion.
- Is accepted in an accredited U.S. or Canadian postsecondary institution.
- Meets the minimum credit score of 625.
- Does not exceed the indebtedness limit for degree level.
- Has ONE qualified cosigner for the loan
- Demonstrates financial need.

Keep your eyes and ears open for deserving women looking for some financial assistance with their education, it just got a little easier!

P.E.O. Scholar Awards

It is not too late to interview an outstanding woman who is within two years of completing her Ph.D. or doctoral-level professional degree!

*Chapter Letters of Recommendation must be submitted online to the International P.E.O. Scholar Awards Office on or before Nov. 20, 2023.

*The International P.E.O. Scholar Awards office will give recommended candidates 45 days to gather the necessary academic records and professorial letters of recommendation, and to complete the lengthy online application for the PSA.

*The 100 successful Scholar Award recipients will be notified in May 2024.

*This \$20,000 award is intended as partial support for the research and writing of the dissertation during the 2024–2025 academic year.

Identifying a potential scholar, interviewing her, and writing the 300-word letter of recommendation is a valuable experience for the P.E.O. chapter, and the lengthy, thought-provoking task of completing the application is excellent for the potential candidate! Even if your candidate does not receive this award, she will have gathered the documents, records, and thoughts so necessary for applying for other grants and scholarships, and she will be well-prepared for the arduous applications and interviews that she will be completing in the years to come.

Please "scatter love" by seeking P.E.O. Scholar Award candidates who will "sparkle" as they pursue their degrees and "shine" in their chosen disciplines. We all benefit from the life-long work of outstanding scholars who may well become our P.E.O. sisters, too!

- Applications for the 2024-2025 P.E.O. STAR Scholarship opened on August 15th and closes on October 15th. Before submitting a recommendation, chapters are encouraged to review the STAR Procedures and General Information document found on the P.E.O. International member website at:

• Once you've found your STAR, stay in touch as she works through the application: process.

- Offer to review her essay. Grammar and spelling are important.
- Be sure she includes all the leadership, community service and extra-curricular activities that she brought to your attention in the interview.
- A well written reference is important. Help her brainstorm a list of adults who know her well.
- The application deadline is crucial. Follow up to ensure she meets her 30-day deadline to submit a completed application.

- Complete a "Willingness to Serve Form" from the NE P.E.O. website. Do this ASAP!
- Contact Lisa ASAP indicating your interest.
- Your chapter will write a letter of support.
- Complete an inventory of skills, experience, etc. and submit it to Lisa. It must be postmarked by November 1, 2023.
- Interviews will take place, likely via Zoom, tentatively in November, 2023.
- The decision will be made and applicants notified soon after the interviews.
