Registration is open for the 2025 Nebraska P.E.O. State Convention. Please be sure to read the directions for determining your convention status on the website before submitting your form.


- Remember that receiving the "SUCCESS" message after you press "submit" signals that your form has been received and a copy of your form has been sent to the email address you provided. (check SPAM/ Junk boxes too!)
- You will NOT receive a bill or confirmation of your reservation for several days, depending on how many forms are submitted each day.
- **DELEGATES!** Be certain your chapter corresponding secretary has entered your name on the International Website **BEFORE** you register! Forms will not be accepted if your delegate status cannot be verified.
- The Younes Center requires rooming lists and counts by May 12, therefore <u>registration will close May 1</u> to have time to finalize that list, as well as the lists for meals, nametags, credentials and on-site registration.
